



BS/MS Accounting 4+1

The BS/MS Accounting 4+1 degree program allows you to complete the BS and MS Accounting degrees in as little as 5 years through substituting two graduate courses for two undergraduate courses. The graduate courses count towards both the BS and MS Accounting degrees. If you are considering the BS/MS Accounting 4+1 degree program, please check the following steps below to ensure your successful plan in your coursework.

Step 1: Meet with your assigned advisor to ensure that you have:

- ✓ Successfully completed **75 or more credits**
- ✓ Successfully completed the intermediate accounting sequence:
 - ACCT 3220, ACCT 3230, ACCT 3320
- ✓ Earned a **3.0** or higher GPA in ACCT 3220, ACCT 3230, ACCT 3320 at the time of application
- ✓ Mapped out courses for 4+1
- ✓ Determined a graduation term
- ✓ Discussed 4+1 effects on CPA 150 credit hours requirement
 - When replacing two undergraduate courses with two graduate courses, a student may be short 6 credits of the 150 total credit hours. Meet with an advisor to discuss total number of credits reached by end of 4+1.

Step 2: Submit your Online Application <https://application.admissions.ucdenver.edu/apply/>

- ✓ Select the term **after** you graduate
- ✓ Email bschool.admissions@ucdenver.edu to let the admissions office know you are applying for the 4+1 and would like to request a GMAT waiver.

****Deadline: Application needs to be submitted two weeks prior to the start of the semester you'll be taking graduate level courses.***

Step 3: Register

- ✓ Once you are **accepted** into the 4+1 program, work with your assigned undergraduate advisor for permission to take two graduate level courses.
- ✓ A grade of C or higher is a passing grade for graduate courses. A cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required in the graduate program. Students need to earn at least a B or higher to begin the graduate program with at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA.
