

New Graduate Student Checklist

1. Student Account and Email

- To set up your student account, go to https://myaccount.ucdenver.edu/claim-account
 - If you have any issues trying to set up your student account, please contact the CU Denver Office of Information Technology
- Email is the official means of communication for CU Denver. Make sure to check your ucdenver.edu email regularly.

2. Student ID

- Students are required to have their student ID with them and visible while on campus
- For information on how to obtain your student ID, visit the ID Station website

3. Canvas

- Instructors will post course content, assignments, and grades online via Canvas.
- Watch our <u>Canvas Tutorial</u> videos and review the <u>Canvas Student Guide</u> prior to your first class
- You can download the Canvas mobile app in the Apple Store or Google Play Store by searching "Canvas Student"

4. Textbooks

- Visit the CU Denver Bookstore website to search for your course textbooks
- Textbook information is usually not available until 1-2 weeks prior to the start of the semester
 - Textbook information can also be found on the course syllabus via Canvas

5. Tuition, Financial Aid, and Scholarships
