After Admission

1. **Set Up Your Student Account and Email**

 - At CU Denver, email is the official means of communication. Check your CU email regularly!

2. **Review Academic and Billing Calendars**

After Enrollment in Courses, but Before the Semester Begins

1. **Obtain Your CU Denver Student ID**

- Obtain your student ID by visiting the [ID Station](#) on campus or online
 - All CU Denver students are required to have their student ID visible while on campus
 - *Note: online students do not need a student ID unless they plan to visit campus*

2. **Complete Immunization Requirement**

- See the [Auraria Health Center](#) website for information on the immunization policy and what paperwork both on-campus and online students will be required to submit
 - The Immunization Requirement must be completed prior to enrolling for the second semester, or a hold will be placed on your student record

3. **Familiarize Yourself with Canvas**

- [Canvas](#) is a web-based learning management system, where instructors will post course content, assignments, learning materials, and grades
