Core classes outlined above are offered in the hybrid format or the online format, primarily in fall and spring, so students can choose their preference in modality. Hybrid courses include 6 to 8 in person meetings per 8-week session complemented with asynchronous content. Online courses are 100% asynchronous (e.g. no meeting days/times).
