## MS in Management and Organization Specialization Options

### **Graduate Business School Specialization Policies:**

- Specialization courses may be offered only once per year; hence, careful planning is required to complete a specialization.
- If you complete a specialization, you must also complete 3 additional **MGMT** courses numbered 6000 or higher to earn all required 18 elective credits.
- Once the degree is completed, a declared specialization will appear on the transcript but not the diploma.
- CMDT/ENTP/GEMM/RISK courses may charge different tuition rates. These courses are not eligible for the CU Employee Tuition Assistance Benefit (TAB).
