



BS/MS International Business 4+1

The BS/MS International Business 4+1 degree program allows you to complete the BS and MS degrees in as little as 5 years through substituting two undergraduate courses with two graduate courses. The graduate courses count towards both the BS / International Business degrees. If you are considering the BS/MS International Business 4+1 degree program, please check the following steps below to ensure your successful plan in your coursework.

Step 1: Meet with your undergraduate advisor to ensure that you have:

- ✓ Successfully completed **75 or more credits**
- ✓ Successfully completed two principles course (3000 level):
 - In a business discipline (e.g., Marketing, Management, Finance, Accounting)
- ✓ Successfully completed one international course at the Business School or another college or school at CU Denver, such as College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, College of Arts and Media (e.g., international perspectives, foreign language courses, international business courses)
 - Earned a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- ✓ Mapped out courses for 4+1
- ✓ Determined a graduation term

Step 2: Submit your Online Application <https://application.admissions.ucdenver.edu/apply/>

- ✓ Select the term **after** you graduate
- ✓ Email bschool.admissions@ucdenver.edu to let the admissions office know you are applying for the 4+1 and would like to request a GMAT waiver.

***Deadline: Application needs to be submitted two weeks prior to the start of the semester you'll be taking graduate level courses**

Step 3: Register

- ✓ Once you are **accepted** into the 4+1 program, work with the undergraduate advisors for permission to take two graduate level courses, preferably one each semester.
- ✓ A grade of C or higher is a passing grade for graduate courses. A cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required in the graduate program. Students need to earn at least a B or higher to begin the graduate program with at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA.
