Work on Campus

International students have the opportunity to seek employment on campus for up to 20 hours a week. Once admitted and enrolled full-time, international students can view available positions and apply on CU Denver's student job board called "Handshake."

*Please note that international students on F-1 students cannot work off campus. After the first academic year, F-1 students may engage in three types of off-campus employment: CPT, OPT & STEM OPT.

Financial Wellness Program

The <u>Financial Wellness program</u> strives to provide resources, guidance, and activities to help students manage their money and build healthy financial habits towards stability.
